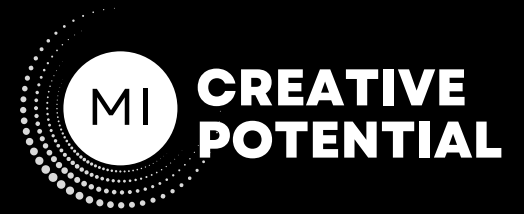


MI CREATIVE POTENTIAL LOGIC MODEL
